



Jim Engh
Tullymore Architect



It is no surprise that Golf World Magazine has named Colorado architect Jim Engh, the designer of the renowned Tullymore Golf Course at the Resorts of Tullymore and St. Ives, as one of the “25 Hottest Golf Architects in the World.” After all, Engh is one of only five living golf course architects that have courses in the Top 50 Greatest Courses in America, as chosen by Golf Digest. **In 2003, Engh was named Golf Digest’s Architect of the Year in America.**

Many other Engh designs besides Tullymore have won wide recognition. Engh’s first U.S. course, Sanctuary, was rated No. 1 in the private category of Golf Digest for Top New Courses and named to the Top 50 of America’s 100 Greatest Golf Courses; Engh became the youngest golf course architect to ever be named to the Top 50 Courses in 1999. Jim’s work on Tullymore and Redlands Mesa continued his successes, having won No. 1 honors from Golf Digest in Upscale Public, Affordable Public, and Private categories.

Engh has over 25 years of experience in course design and started his own firm in 1991. He learned his trade from such distinguished architects as Dick Nugent, Ken Dye and Joe Finger. He also served as director of golf course design with legendary British firm, Cotton Pennick.

When he received his Architect of the Year honors, he told Golf Digest: “I know we have to please golfers the first time out, but I also try to design other levels into our courses so that you’ll learn something new about every hole every time you play it.”

That’s certainly true of Tullymore, a course that you as a golfer will want to play again and again.
