

Job Title: Golf Course Mechanic

Reports: Superintendent

Summary/Objective:

This position is responsible for repairing and providing preventative upkeep on all golf course maintenance related equipment. Equipment includes, but is not limited to; mowers, utility vehicles, small equipment, tractors, and other equipment associated with the maintenance of the golf course.

Job Functions:

- Must contain a valid Michigan Driver License
- Fabricates and welds with a variety of different tools
- Diagnoses gas and diesel engines, hydraulic systems, and electrical systems
- Experienced in the diagnosis and repair of gas & diesel engines, hydraulic systems, and electrical systems
- Other Duties deemed necessary by supervisors

Prerequisites:

Must have oral communication skills, excel within a team dynamic, strong organizational skills, and exceptional time management.

Preferred Experience:

Experience in the golf industry, as well as, mechanical experience.

Position Type and Hours of Work:

This is a 9-month salary position, which averages about 40 hours per week.

Working Conditions:

Work hours may include days and evenings on weekdays and weekends. Subject to inside and outside environmental conditions. May be exposed to inclement weather, potentially dangerous chemicals, solvents, pesticides, herbicides, and fertilizers, misdirected golf balls, sharp and rapid equipment movement on a daily basis. Injury may result as a result of exposure to the above if safety policies and practices are not properly followed.

Physical Requirements:

Must have the ability to:

- Read and write (English)
- Communicate verbally with staff members and/or customers with or without the use of two-way radios.
- Give and/or follow verbal and written instructions
- Visually inspect all work areas, golf course, grounds, and equipment
- See players on the golf course, and to follow the flight of golf balls
- Operate vehicles and equipment for several hours at a time
- Perform mathematical calculations involving fractions, decimals, and percentages
- Retrieve, read and interpret information from technical sources
- Stand, sit, walk, push, pull, lift, grasp, bend and kneel for up to 5 hours at a time
- Lift up to 100 lbs occasionally, 50 lbs frequently, and 20 lbs constantly
