- Stage practice area in the evening for the next day.
- Clean and charge every golf cart after each round.
- Must maintain a clean and organized work area at all times.
- Make sure the cart basement is secured before departing each evening.
- Detail golf carts on schedule basis.
- Properly prepare golf carts for member tournaments, corporate outings, and group outings.
- Ensure all opening and closing procedures are done as directed by the Head and Assistant Golf Professional.
